

Rubbish disposal






Bin space: we have limited bin space (especially in the black general waste bin) and we are committed to reducing landfill.

Blue bin: Please put any items that will recycle in the blue bin (see separate list below).

PLEASE NOTE ITEMS THAT DO NOT RECYCLE here, such as yoghurt pots, foil. Food trays do not recycle as they are plastic coated. The same applies to disposable coffee cups.

Green box (by bins): please put glass and Tetrapaks in the green box outside.

Compost bin: Vegetable & fruit waste (e.g. peelings) and teabags can go in the compost bin outside the kitchen back door. The green bags for this are compostable. Do not compost any meat or dairy product waste.
