Please open the windows in the bedrooms to air the room whenever you can.

End of shifts: By the end of your shift,

- Our son's bedroom and all of his area is to be clean and tidy. This includes the kitchen, fridge, freezer, hob, oven and cupboards
- Floors swept
- His sling, harness, arm rests to be checked and washed if needed, such that they will be dry for the next day
- Any used bibs to be rinsed and washed
- Also check the front and back garden for anything left out such as toys and cushions.
